# Tetiaroa's ultimate cruise



Discover the treasures hidden on the atoll of Tetiaroa with a naturalist guide from Tetiaroa Society's foundation during a 3 1/2-hour excursion.

A boat ride will bring you closer to the motus located on the east and north side. Here, you will explore the various richness of their ecosystems which encompass primary forest, coconut crabs, numerous species of birds, and marine life such as string rays, spotted eagle rays, black tip sharks, lemon sharks, jackfish, and milkfish.

Then enjoy a swim break on a sand bar showcasing marvelous, panoramic views from the atoll, which concludes your excursion.

# Bird Discovery Tour



Tetiaroa is a special place for sea bird nesting and also a privileged observation place for ornithologists. Accompanied by the naturalists of the Te Mana o te Moana foundation, you will participate in collecting data on boobies, terns, noddies or egrets.

You will discover the ornithological richness of the atoll of Tetiaroa during your 2 1/2-hour excursion to various sites.

# Reef quest

You will also visit the organic garden where fruits and vegetables are grown and where some of Tetiaroa's bee hives are located which provide the delicious honey used in our restaurants and bars.

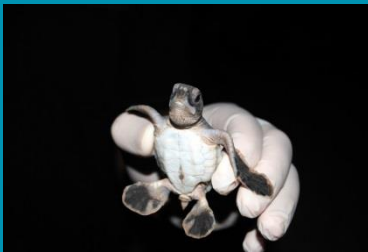
# turtle night



The atoll of Tetiaroa is a major site of sea turtle nesting in French Polynesia. The nonprofit foundation Te Mana o te Moana is studying to take a census of sea turtle nesting for more than 8 years. At nightfall, join them and depending on the season, hope you might see a sea turtle laying her eggs or a hatchling of the babies. A huge moment of intensity! This Eco touristic activity is respecting the wellbeing of the animals, and is attending to not disturb them. Only guides allowed will be able to tag or take measures on the sea turtles encountered. This activity corresponds to current scientific research.
